## **Service Spotlight: Mesotherapy**

First Equine is proud to start offering Mesotherapy! This involves tiny injections given under the skin (mesoderm layer) that penetrate about 4mm deep.

This therapy is used for horses with chronic back or neck pain that helps to stop the muscle spasm/pain cycle. It helps to inhibit pain fibers coming off the dorsal horn of the spinal cord, much like acupuncture.
